Rural Youth To Present
Large And Varied Program

Hundreds of farm people from every section of the Province are expected to gather today at the Provincial Exhibition grounds in Charlottetown to witness the completion of the 7th Annual Rural Youth Fair, which opened here last evening. The 2nd annual Harvest Exhibition is being held in conjunction with the older event.

As its name implies the Rural Youth Fair places the accent on rural youth achievement. The fall event marks the culmination of the year's work of the provincial 4-H Clubs, and includes a program of sports, in addition to a public speaking contest which was held last night.

The Harvest Exhibition will put in competition every type of crop produced in the province - vegetable, grain, fruit, etc. Entries are expected from every section of the Island.

In the 4-H Club finals calves of every breed will be shown.

The three top winners in each Club are eligible to enter, and will compete at the central fair with other provincial winners of the same breed. Prizes will be awarded to each club placing first, and to grand and reserve champions in each breed. The 4-H poultry and garden club provincial championships will also be determined at this event.

Sixty-eight calf clubs are eligible to send their top 1957 winners to the fall fair. Breed-wise, these are distributed as follows: Holsteins - Thirty Ayrshires eleven; Guernseys - three; Jerseys - one; Dual-Purpose Short horn six; Beef - seventeen. Only two competitors are eligible in the poultry clubs, and six in the garden clubs.

Cattle judging will be conducted by Mr. Stewart Eagles, of the Canada Department of Agriculture, Moncton, N.B. The remaining farm exhibits will be placed by local provincial and dominion department of agricultural experts.
