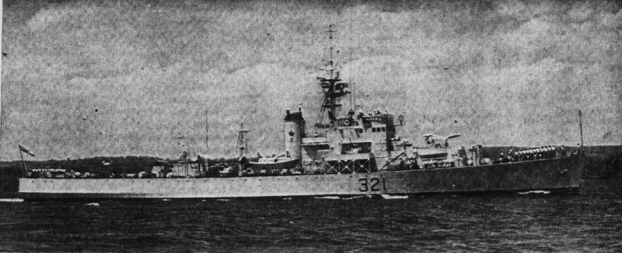


HMCS FORT ERIE COMMISSIONED IN 1943-44 SA W SERVICE CHASING SUBMARINES IN ATLANTIC
