MONTREAL, Dec. 10 (CP)—The United States dollar today closed at 2 1/2 cent premium to the Canadian dollar, up 1/4 from Saturday's close. That is, it took \$1.02 1/2 Canadian to buy \$1 American. The pound sterling was \$2.86 5/16, up 11/16 from Saturday.
