### Reaction To China Trade Is Cautious

Four Canadian automobile manufacturers reacted cautiously Friday to indications in Ottawa that they may be allowed to sell cars to Red China without penalties on their United States parent firms.

Prime Minister Diefenbaker told the House of Commons that President Eisenhower had promised to "consider favorably" the U.S. parent firms of Canadian subsidiaries trading with Communist China.

Spokesmen for Ford, General Motors, Chrysler and Studebaker-Packard in Canada said they would "give consideration" to orders from China. But none of the firms said flatly they would sell automotive products to China. Studebaker-Packard and General Motors ruled out any immediate sales on the grounds they would not have the cars available.

Rhys M. Sale, Ford president, indicated the company would sell cars to China if satisfactory terms and proper export permits could be arranged.

He said a report some months ago that Ford of Canada had been asked to supply 1,000 cars to China was not correct. This report, which said Ford had refused to order because of U.S. penalties, ignited a Canada-U.S. controversy.

Ford had received inquiries about the 1,000-car order, he said, but at no time did it get a firm order for cars from Red China.

### Mr. Canada On Mining Is Off On Ghana Job

OTTAWA (CP)—Dr. Gilbert (Slim) Monture, a full-blooded Canadian Indian who became world expert on base metals, is another country to add to his personal map showing far-off places where his mining knowledge comes in handy.

At 62, the man who has been called the "Mr. Canada" of mining is off on a new assignment. He's on his way to Ghana to make a six-week survey of marginal gold mines, the latest in a chain of mining studies that have taken him to Malaya, Indonesia, Israel and Bolivia as well as Washington, London, The Hague, Paris and Geneva.

Dr. Monture left Ottawa Thursday and is expected in Accra July 14.

He joined the Canadian government's mines department in 1956. He retired two years ago as chief of the department's mineral resources division to take a job with a private mining company.

OTTAWA (CP)—The staff of Parliament is not available to ghost-write speeches for Commons members, two Ottawa MPs reminded their colleagues Thursday.

George McIlraith (L—Ottawa West) said he has had "the impression there is a little pressure" on library staff toward such duties.

Frank McGee (PC—York-Scarborough), attending the same joint Senate - Commons library meeting, said there is a great shortage of ghost writers — persons who anonymously write speeches for others.
