

# Canadian Climbers Slowed In Pakistan

OTTAWA (CP)—A Canadian mountaineering expedition has run into trouble in its effort to climb a 22,500-foot peak in the

Karakoram Mountains of west Pakistan. A report written June 23 by Dr. Fred Roots, 41-year-old expedition leader, said the attempt to climb the peak has been postponed while the party makes a further study of possible routes of ascent. The report was written by Dr. Roots, a federal government geologist from Wakefield, Que., at a camp located at an altitude of 16,000 feet. He wrote it on his knee in the dark. The expedition's official objective is to reach Hachindar Kish, in the Hachindar Kish region of the Karakoram Mountains. Dr. Roots' report said the peak is the principal point of the Hachindar Kish. He describes it as a "high slender, delicate" of unbelievably delicate proportions that dominates the entire region and seems to be the highest mountain in the whole section of the Great Karakoram Range. All members of the Canadian party are well. In fact, Dr. Roots says while some have had difficulty acclimating themselves to altitudes of nearly 18,000 feet, the party's high-altitude porters have had more trouble than the Canadians. The porters on the whole carry lighter loads and twice have had to be sent lower to recuperate. Dr. Roots said Hachindar Kish peak is steep and narrow, rising more than 10,500 feet directly from the Muchholi Glacier Valley and bounded by vertical cliffs more than 5,000 feet high on the west and northeast sides. Despite reconnaissance on the southwest, east and north sides, the Canadian expedition could not see any possible or potential route of ascent. **POSTPONE ATTEMPTS** "Attempts to climb Hachindar Kish have been postponed, therefore until the party can get a higher and closer look at the upper part of the peak," he wrote. "To accomplish this the party has turned its attention to a beautiful and symmetrical snow and ice mountain previously unknown which lies about five miles northeast of what has now been named Hachindar Kish." The snow and ice mountain has been named by the party as Sangamarmur, or Beautiful Yellow Snow, because of its conspicuous cap of yellow marble that caps the summit and makes the mountain unique in this region. Reconnaissance of a possible route up Sangamarmur, which is about 22,000 feet high, began June 13. Successive camps, each a day's carry higher than the last, have been established on the west flank of the mountain. On June 23 five camps above the base camp had been established. The entire party of eight Canadians was at camp four and five, at 15,000 feet and 17,500 feet, respectively. Camp five is on a narrow hanging glacier on the southeast side of a second or subsidiary peak. Several reconnaissances have shown that the north and west sides of this mountain cannot be climbed. However, it was now thought that if a way could be found past the subsidiary peak to place a sixth camp at about 18,500 feet the summit might be reached.
