Several Types Of Meat Make Very Good Steak

"When is a steak not a steak — I mean to the average person?" chuckled the Chef. "When it's a cut of any meat except beef," he answered himself.

"In reality, there are several meats beside beef that make very good steaks. For example: veal steak, pork steak, ham steak, liver steak, venison steak and lamb steak.

NEW IDEA
"A new idea is turkey steak cut from the breasts of large birds," I suggested.

"Any kind of tender meat that

can be sliced an inch or more thick, and broiled or sauteed, is really steak. When homemakers realize this and buy more of the other varieties, the price of first-quality beef steak will drop. Homemakers still do not realize how much influence they can exert on prices."

TOMORROW'S DINNER
California tossed salad, broiled lamb chops, browned whole potatoes, broccoli mimosa, apricot-raisin compote, coffee, tea, milk.

Measurements are level. Recipes for 4 to 6.

California tossed salad: Combine one small head shredded, cleaned, washed Romaine lettuce, 1/2 bunch cleaned, drained water cress, large stems removed, and 2 stalks thin-sliced cleaned celery. Add one peeled thick-sliced medium zucchini. Toss and chill.

Just before serving, toss again with 1/2 c. Italian style dressing. Garnish with 1 large tomato, cut in eighths.

Broccoli Mimosa: Wash, drain and trim 2 lbs. fresh broccoli. Cut large stalks in quarters; split to cook through as quickly as the tender broccoli tops.

Place in a saucepan. Pour in boiling water to depth of 1/2 in. Add 1/2 tsp. salt. Cook uncovered five min.

Cover and cook until fork-tender, about 20 min.

Meantime, make 2 c. medium-thick white sauce, using 2 c. milk or 1 1/2 c. milk and 1/2 c. chicken broth. Season with 1/4 tsp. powdered mustard.

Cook 3 eggs until hard boiled. Slice 2 of the eggs and the white of 1. Add to the sauce.

Put remaining hard-cooked yolk through a sieve and reserve.
