I HEREBY GIVE PUBLIC NOTICE that on Tuesday the 17th day of May A.D. 1966 at the hour of eleven o'clock in the forenoon in front of the Law Courts Building in Charlottetown in Queens County in Prince Edward Island I will set up and sell to the highest bidder all the right title and interest of the person in whose name the said property is assessed being the following real estate situated at Vernon in Lot No. 50 in Queens County aforesaid and described as follows: -
