Ice is the solid form of water. The invention of the micro-thermometer made possible a study of ice formation under different conditions. The freezing point of water at atmospheric pressure is given as 0° Centigrade or 32° Fahrenheit.

Water is composed of hydrogen and oxygen and is called an associated fluid represented by the molecular symbol H2O. The familiar three forms of water: steam, or water vapour, liquid and ice, however assume different molecular aggregates.

Roentgen in 1892 stated that water contained ice in solution above the freezing point, and these ice molecules have since been identified as trihydrol.

In watching ice form under a microscope, it had been noted, that at first only small disc-like particles appear, as with a true colloid, these flocculate and grow, somewhat similar to the jelly formed when a jelly powder is mixed with water.

When ice forms under natural conditions, it first appears as a cloudy mass, something like the appearance of the "Milky Way", when this occurs in river rapids it is followed by the formation of needles or what the French call "frazil" ice which is produced throughout the mass of churned water and has very little buoyancy.

Physical Constants of Ice The maximum density of water at atmospheric pressure occurs at 39 degrees Fahrenheit or 4 degrees Centigrade. Water that is warmer than that, has less density, and rises. When water cools below that temperature it also loses its density and rises so that the water in our rivers and bays, after its temperature falls below 39°F, is always colder at the surface where ice forms.

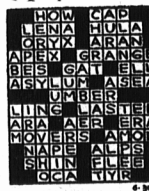
