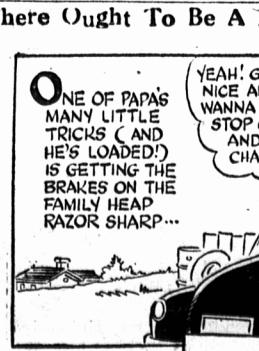
With the exception of one member who was absent from the province, every member of the Summerside Kinsmen Club was present at the regular meeting of the club at Robson's Restaurant last evening.
