County Meets Are Underway

Track and field got off to a flying start at Memorial Field yesterday afternoon as the Queens County elementary meet kicked off the season at the local field.

It wasn't so many years ago that these county meets were completed with one day's activity, but now due to the increased entries in the various events it has been necessary for the officials to spread the competition over a two day period.

Although the spectators turn out didn't set any records for yesterday's activity the events were well filled and the competition was keen.

The Prince County elementary meet was staged in Summerside yesterday afternoon while the elementary representatives from the eastern end of the province were decided at Montague.

The high school competitors will hold the spotlight on the Island track scene today with the Queens County meet scheduled for Memorial Field, Prince County, Kensington and Kings County, Montague.

Entries from each school in these County competitions are limited to two and only the first and second place winners from the County meets will be eligible to take part in the provincial meets.

Ribbons are awarded to first, second and third place winners in the county meets while in the provincial meet gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first three athletes.

Activity is scheduled to get underway at Memorial Field this morning and will continue through the day.

The athletes will be going out to win a berth in the Provincial meets.

The provincial elementary meet will be held at the Summerside Sports Complex, June 4, 2:00 p.m. The provincial high school competition will be staged at the Summerside Sports Complex June 5 with action getting underway at 10 a.m.

Tid Bits From Here And There

Parker MacDonald, traded to Boston Bruins from the Red Wings and last-place Boston completed a multiple player National Hockey League trade Friday which sends veterans Al Langlois and Parker MacDonald to the Bruins for Ab McDonald and Bob McCord.

The Red Wings, kings of the regular season but eliminated in the Stanley Cup first round, also swapped right-wing Bob Dillabough and wing-defenceman Ron Harris with defenceman Langlois and wigg McCord.

The Bruins in return include rookie defenceman Ken Stephenson with left-wing Ab McDonald and defenceman McCord, who finished out last season with Hershey of the American Hockey League.

Ab McDonald was with the Bruins last season after being acquired from Chicago a year ago. He had a disappointing campaign and had been ridden severely by local fans. He started with a training camp injury and didn't hit his stride until the final weeks.

McCord was farmed to Hershey early in the season. Stephenson, hampered by a knee injury, never came closer to Boston than the Minneapolis farm club.
