A 6

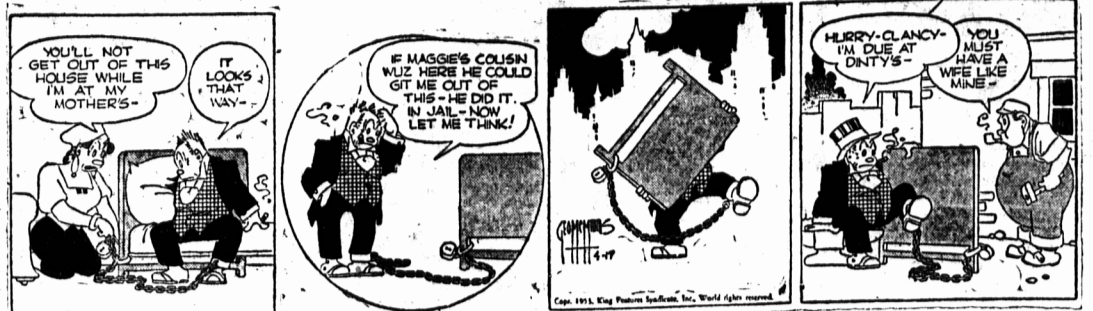
The bidding:
East South West North
4 4 4 4
5 4 4 4
Pass 6 6 (final bid)

West opened the diamond king. The ace won, and declarer drew two rounds of trumps...

If either the missing trumps or the diamonds had broken 2-2, South's plan would have been good...

That being so, there was a strong probability that the trumps also were divided 3-1, with East holding the length. His bidding virtually marked him with eight clubs...

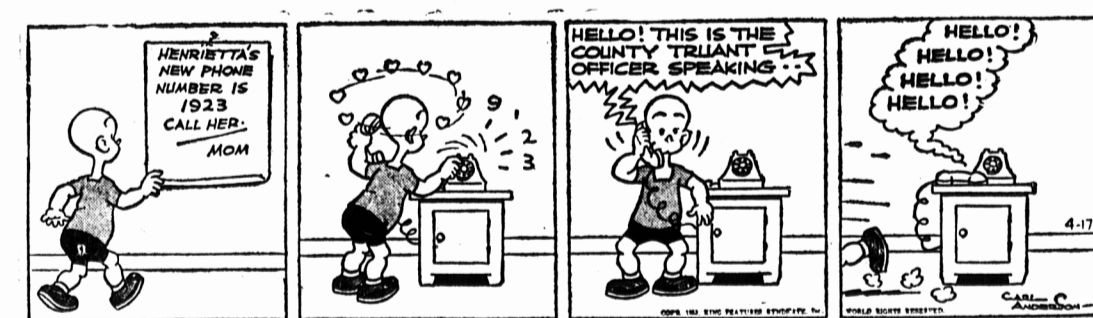
