

West Prince Trade Bd. Plans Transit Shed Plan

ALBERTON — The construction of a transit shed at Alberton wharf is most gratifying to the Alberton and West Prince Board of Trade stated J. Frank Bryan, president of the board at the regular meeting last night.

This project has been urged by the board for some time and is tied-in with efforts to restore shipping of produce and other goods from the port of Alberton. Tenders have been called for a draft proof building located on the railway wharf.

Rev. David MacDonald, chairman of the board's transportation committee, presented a brief report of developments leading up to the decision of the Board of Transport Commissioners to hold a hearing in to the CNR's proposal for entrenchment of railway services in Prince County.

Preparations are underway for the board to present a brief at the hearing and approval was given for the chairman to engage an attorney to prepare the brief.

On motion, Mr. MacDonald was appointed an accredited delegate to the annual meeting of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce in Quebec on Oct. 6-7-8 and 9.

A brief is also to be presented to the West Prince economic survey scheduled for Alberton on Sept. 25.

Next Monday, the secretary of the board, C. R. Leard, plans to attend a quarterly meeting in Moncton of the Maritime Provinces Board of Trade.
