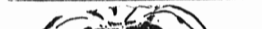

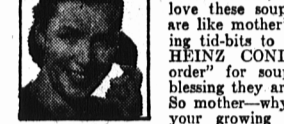
didn't... The door to the Principal's house fell shut behind a young man who plunged down the steps and off at random, anywhere his feet took him.
