

**Saint John  
Given Okay  
On Car Tax**

FREDERICTON (CP) — A scale of motor vehicle taxes proposed by the city of Saint John received the approval here of the legislature's municipalities committee.

Under the amendment to the city assessment act, owners of passenger cars not more than three years old will be taxed \$40, from three to six years old \$30, and more than six years old \$20.

Tax on commercial vehicles of less than one-ton would be \$50 and buses with a passenger capacity of more than 15 persons would be taxed \$200.

**Japan Given  
Salmon Boost**

TOKYO (AP)—Japan and the Soviet Union have agreed to set Japan's 1965 quota of salmon fishing in the northwestern Pacific at 115,000 tons, or 1,000 tons more than last year's quota.

The fishery agency said the agreement was reached at the Japan-Soviet fishery commission's plenary session.

The agency said the Soviet quota of salmon fishing will be fixed some time before the Japan-Soviet fishery agreement for 1965 is signed on April 2.

**Moncton Men  
Injured In  
Sealing Crash**

GRINDSTONE, Que. (CP) — Two Moncton men were expected to leave hospital late this week after being injured in the crash of a single-engine plane last Friday near this community on the Magdalen Islands.

Hospital officials said Charles Leitch, 39, and his 21-year-old son James, both of Moncton, were not seriously injured when the plane crashed between a house and a barn while en route to the ice off the islands to pick up seal pelts. Their doctor said the two were expected to be released from hospital Friday.

**B.C. Indians  
May Receive  
Legal Aid**

OTTAWA (CP)—Two British Columbia Indians whose rights to hunt out of season have been upheld by the province's court of appeal will be offered legal aid by the federal government if the province appeals to the Supreme Court of Canada, Citizenship Minister Nicholson said here.

Mr. Nicholson told the Commons it has been departmental practice to give legal aid in cases concerning Indians' hunting and fishing rights where the expected decision will clarify the law.

The B.C. Court of Appeal has upheld a previous decision that a royal proclamation of 1763 giving Indians on the west coast of North America their hunting and fishing rights still applies to West Coast Indians.

Clifford White and David Bob of the Nanaimo Indian band shot deer out of season to feed their families. They were charged and convicted by a magistrate under B.C. game laws, but a county court judge reversed the decision. The province's appeal to the B.C. Appeal Court was rejected.

Reports have indicated the province may appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada.

**ESCAPES CHAIR**

AKRON, Ohio (AP) — Leroy Dunlop, who eluded the electric chair for 44 years after breaking jail, was sentenced Tuesday to one to 20 years in Ohio penitentiary for a 1920 robbery-slaying of a man. Dunlop, 64, was sentenced by a three-judge panel, which denied probation. He will be eligible for a parole hearing in 10 months and could be released from prison in 11 months.

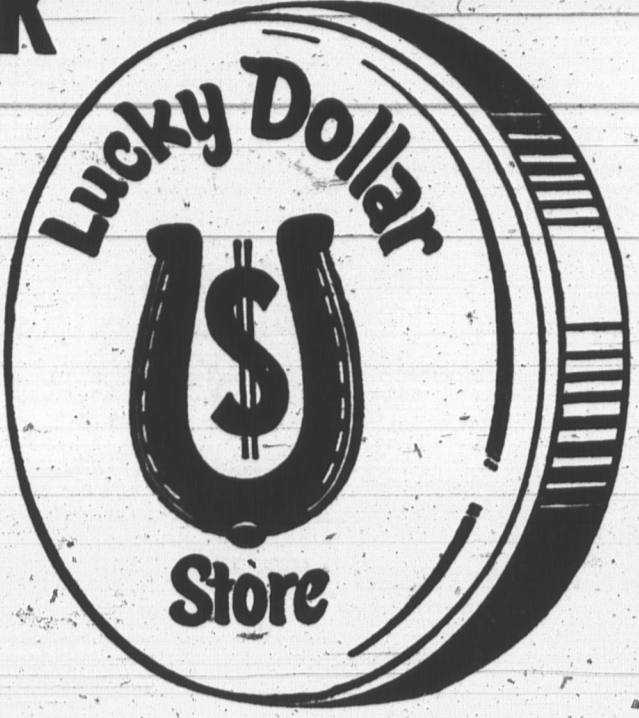
