Russians Announce New Type A-Bombs Tested

MOSCOW, (AP)—The Soviet government announced Thursday night it has successfully tested some "new type" atomic bombs in the last few weeks.

A dispatch from the Soviet news agency Tass published in the government newspaper Izvestia said the successful experimental tests had taken place.

The dispatch said that although the Soviet Union was able to give attention to the production of atomic weapons, the nation also followed a policy of strengthening peace and trying to reach agreement with other countries on the prohibition of atomic, hydrogen bombs and other kinds of weapons for mass destruction.

No details were given about the "new type" tested.

Experts Cautious Over Value Of Polio Weapon

ROME, (AP)—Experts of the World Health Organization cautioned Saturday against overconfidence in gamma globulin as a weapon against poliomyelitis.

They said an effective vaccination control may be available in the near future but urged patience.

Development of vaccines is still in an experimental stage, and those of unquestionable value "are not yet available for current use," the experts declared.

Studies of vaccine research and other methods of fighting poliomyelitis were reported on by a group of experts meeting here under the chairmanship of Prof. John R. Paul of the Yale University school of medicine.

Their report said experiments in the United States showed gamma globulin appeared to afford protection against the paralytic diseases over a period of five to six weeks—but no protection was demonstrated during the weeks immediately following inoculation.

That meant the experts feared gamma globulin's effects are too slow.

"The committee is of the opinion that the practical application of gamma globulin as a prophylactic in poliomyelitis is greatly limited," for even when employed under the most favorable conditions hundreds or thousands of people will be unnecessarily inoculated for every one who actually derives protection from the infection."

The report added that the best use for gamma globulin, protectively, is for "mass inoculation in epidemics, and to prevent infection in persons closely connected with polio victims."

It said "other circumstances in which a protective dose of gamma globulin can be justifiably administered include essential ton-ill operations, and in pregnancy, since in the later months of pregnancy polio may take a very severe form."
