Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) — The stock market edged lower Wednesday but the decline was mild and quiet.

A last-hour flurry of profit-taking helped reduce prices, especially in the western oil section which recorded an index loss of more than two points. The base metal index was off almost a point.

The market, which usually follows in line with New York, failed to do so Wednesday. New York recorded a moderate advance but its action didn't shake Toronto. International Nickel gained a point among senior base metals while Labrador added 1/2. Hudson Bay was down 1/2. Among other base metal issues, Nickel Rim and Belcher lost 25 cents, Chibougamau faceted dipped 15 cents and Barrick gained 15 cents.

Great Falls featured western oils, advancing a point. Calgary and Edmonton, however, lost 1/4 and 1/2 respectively. Dome Explorations (Western) was off 25 cents and Vico, which lost 45 cents yesterday, was off 15 cents.

Devonian and General Petroleum gained 20 cents. Baniff was up 15 cents.

Index losses: golds off .41 to .85.86; base metals off .91 to 256.45; western oils off 2.06 to 176.23.
