MONTREAL (CP)—U.S. dollar in terms of Canadian funds unchanged 1-3/4 at \$1.07%.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market Friday ended with another loss. Trading was active.

Volume was 9,950,000 shares compared with 9,920,000 Thursday.

Of 1,423 issues traded, 502 rose and 67 fell.

Nine of the 15 most active stocks declined and six advanced.

Transit was the most active stock for the second straight session but lost 1/4 of the 2 1/4 it gained Thursday.

American Motors, up 1/4 at 11 1/4, was second most active and was purchased on strings of sizable transactions.

STUDEBAKER GAINS 1/4
Studebaker held a gain of 1/4 at 40 1/4.

Among other widely swinging issues, Magnavox fell 3/4, Motorola 7/8, Texas Gulf Sulphur 7/8, Polaroid 4/4 and Xerox 3/4.

Douglas Aircraft declined 3/4. In addition to the market downturn Douglas was affected by news that a Douglas DC-8 airliner operated by Canadian Pacific Airlines crashed in Tokyo.

Among Canadian issues traded, Canadian Pacific rose 1/4, McIntyre Porcupine 1/2 and Walker Gooderham 1/4.

International Nickel fell 1/4 and Dieltiens Seagrass and Hudson Bay Mining 1/4 apiece.

Prices were irregularly lower on the American exchange. Volume was 3,480,000 shares compared with 3,540,000 Thursday.

Canadian Javelin and Scurry Rainbow Oil fell 1/4 while Radian Tractor gained 1/4.

The industrial index dropped 0.36 to 165.53. Utilities were down 0.22 at 150.09.

Interprovincial Pipe Line dropped one point to 83. Newfoundland Light and B.C. Telephone eased 1/4 to 11 1/4 and 77.

BANKS DECLINE
Banks declined 0.20 at 122.39. Canadian National led the individual issues, sliding 1/4 to 6 1/4 and Nova Scotia 1/4 to 70 1/4.

Papers jumped 0.21 at 124.22. Abitibi and Consolidated added 1/4 to 12 1/4 and 40 1/4.

Fraser climbed 1/4 to 29 1/4 and MacMillan Bloedel and Powell River 1/4 to 28 1/4.

Senior metals were mixed. Among the primary issues Canada Iron added 1/4 to 22 1/4 and Steel of Canada 1/4 to 24 1/4.

Algonia eased 1/4 to 67 1/4. In the base section International Nickel rose 1/4 to 100 1/4.

Falconbridge slipped 1/4 to 101. Senior oils were off. Home dropped 1/4 to 18 1/4 and Pacific 1/4 to 12 1/4.

Among speculative mines and oils Jubilee rose 25 cents to \$2.60.

Russians Reject N-Arms Proposal

GENEVA (CP)—The Soviet Union has rejected as "unacceptable" an American proposal to halt the spread of nuclear weapons.

Soviet delegate Semyon K. Tsarapkin served notice to the 17-nation disarmament conference that the Soviet government considers its own draft proposal the only basis for an eventual agreement.

Tsarapkin charged the American draft treaty "lacks several important obligations" and said it contains these loopholes:

"It carries no obligation to give to non-nuclear states the right of participation in the ownership, disposal and use of nuclear weapons."
