The first league encounter for the Lady Panthers will come on Wednesday December 6 at 5:30 p.m. when they host Mount Allison University.

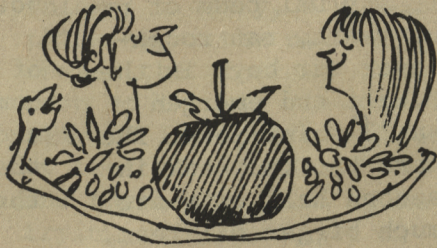

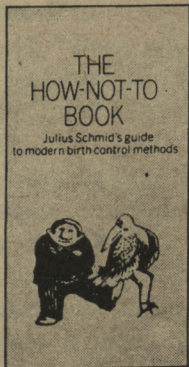
