

Over 200 Students Make Deans' Honor List At UPEI

Two hundred and twenty-one students have been named to the Dean's Honors List at the University of Prince Edward Island for first semester, 1979-80, the Registrar's Office announced today. To merit inclusion on the list a student must obtain 80 per cent or higher on a normal study load of five courses. A breakdown by academic years shows 84 seniors, 53 juniors, 41 sophomores and 43 freshmen.

The list indicates the island high schools from which the students graduated as well as those who graduated from out-of-province schools, and mature and special students. Following is the list:

DEANS' LIST ANALYZED

The Deans' List is available for all to see. Many have looked through the list for their names, the names of friends, acquaintances, and those whose names they have heard of at one time or another. While some have simply looked at the names, others have analyzed the data critically.

The curious might ask, "Why do the names appear in order of the high schools which the students attended?" The answer was given to me by Frank Ledwell, the Dean of Arts. The listing reflects the provincial commitment of the university. The high schools can use the list as a quick reference for illustrating the success of their graduates. It is also easy for the Guardian's local audiences to readily observe the progress of students from their areas.

An interesting analytical observation comes from comparing the figures above to the official enrollment figures listed in Topics. 16.6% of the full-time enrolled students are on the Deans' List. This means that one of every six UPEI students is an honours student.

The class breakdowns are even more interesting. 26.9% of all seniors are listed, 23.3% of all juniors are listed, 12.9% of all sophomores are listed, and only 9.6% of all freshmen are listed. The variation can be explained in two ways. The quality of students improve by class, and the weaker students may drop out over the years.

One must recall that UPEI has 449 freshmen, 318 sophomores, 277 juniors, and 312 seniors. Unfortunately the data required for analyzing the percentage of honours students in each faculty was unavailable at the time of print.

Now we come to another question. How will the Deans honor these successful students? Professor Ledwell had the answer to this question as well. He informed me that the annual Deans' Dinner, which was held in the past, would be too expensive considering the number of students concerned. In its place a special event will be dedicated to the students. It will include a wine and cheese reception, a live band, and a guest speaker.

The guest speaker will be Murray Crede. Mr. Crede is currently the producer of CBC's Marketplace. Mr. Crede is a native Islander who studied at the Prince of Wales College. He is a professional agriculturalist and was at one time the single field representative for the Department of Agriculture on PEI. The special event will be held on campus sometime in late March.
