PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE.

TUESDAY, May 10.

At the afternoon session, after the transaction of routine business, Mr. Arthur Peters submitted the following amendment to the amendment introduced by Hon. Mr. Gordon, regarding our claims upon the Dominion.

That the following paragraph be struck out of the said amendment, namely, "That this Legislative Assembly express its deep disappointment at the reply of the Premier of the Dominion as well as at the fruitless result of the mission of the delegation" and the following substituted in lieu thereof: "That this Legislative Assembly desires to place upon record an expression of satisfaction in the manner in which the delegation recently sent by the Provincial Government to Ottawa have pressed our claims upon the consideration of the Federal Government, and the House concurs in the course they have pursued in asking that all claims of this Province against the Dominion be submitted to an independent board of arbitration for adjustment and settlement."

The subject matter of this resolution was discussed until six o'clock.

At the evening session Hon. Mr. Warburton made the usual motion regarding the granting of supply. In so doing he intimated that it was not his intention to make comparison regarding the expenditure of the different administrations; but he proposed to discuss the financial position of the province upon its merits. At the end of last December the liabilities of the Province consisted of \$185,000 of debentures. From these debentures there is to be deducted a sinking fund amounting at the end of last year to \$8,662.44 leaving the total debenture debt at \$176,337.56. At the end of the year there was also a temporary loan account (Continued on page 8.)
