## Muggeridge Complaint

LONDON (Reuters) — Britain's Press Council yesterday night rejected writer Malcolm Muggeridge's complaint that two London Sunday newspapers published "distorted" reports on his article on Queen Elizabeth in an American magazine.

The council, a voluntary organization formed to keep an eye on journalistic ethics, said The People and the Sunday Express had a right to say his article contained "a number of unfair, untimely and wounding disparagements of the Royal Family."

Muggeridge lodged his complaint after his article in the Saturday Evening Post stirred up heated controversy here. The article was entitled "Does Britain Really Need a Queen?"

Muggeridge said the Press Council's statement came as no surprise and is "woolly, inconclusive, feeble and mistaken."

The council said Muggeridge's accusation against the newspapers was not justified. At the same time, it expressed regret that the two newspapers had omitted all the writer's references to the credit of the Royal Family.

SAYS JOBS LOST — Muggeridge complained the newspaper accounts resulted in his losing television and writing assignments.

The council was told Tuesday by the Queen's press secretary, Cmdr. Richard Colville, that the Royal Family's private lives were being increasingly "disrupted" by certain sections of the press.

## U. S. Newspaper Ads Increase

CHICAGO (CP) — Newspaper circulation and advertising revenue in the United States set records in 1957, the Newspaper Advertising Executive Association reports.

Advertisers also put more into newspaper advertising than in television, radio, magazines and billboards combined, association President Gilbert P. Swanson told the association's annual meeting Tuesday.

Despite the record peak in advertising revenues, preliminary checks indicated that advertising income declined about three per cent.

The added income came from higher line rates, increased use of color and selling more premium space. Final figures on advertising income are not available, he said.

The climb marked the 12th year in the last 13 that newspaper revenue set a record.

Newspaper circulation in the U.S. last year averaged 58,600,000 copies a day.

## 7 Charged In Cheque Thefts

OTTAWA (CP) — Seven men, including a former police officer, have appeared in Hull and Ottawa in courts in connection with the theft of 1,500 blank civil service cheques from the federal treasury office.

Two men appeared in court Tuesday and five more Wednesday as city police and the RCMP continued their investigation into the Friday theft. Police said they expect to lay more charges.

Lawrence Gourlay, 23, of Ottawa, a former member of the city police department, was remanded without plea or election Wednesday in Hull court.

In Ottawa court, Orville Belaire, 25, and Arthur Carey, 23, pleaded not guilty to charges arising out of the cheque thefts. Marcel (Mike) Berthiaume, 27, was remanded without plea or election and Orville Gregoire, 23, chose trial by judge and jury.

In Hull court Tuesday, Douglas Arthur Fox, 20, of nearby Eastview, Ont., was remanded one week for sentence after pleading guilty to a charge of trying to obtain money by false pretences. Leslie Matthews, 27, of Ottawa was remanded without plea to Jan. 21 on the same charge.

## Al Capone's Car Changes Hands

MANCHESTER, England (Reuters) — Al Capone's bullet-proof Cadillac was sold for \$178 at an auction Wednesday and may return to the United States.

Tony Stuart, buyer of the 30-year-old, armor-plated sedan that carried the late gangster around Chicago during prohibition days, said he will advertise the car for sale in the U.S.

"I hope to make money on it," added Stuart, a dance hall operator.

The car was brought to Britain and was put on show in 1942 at Belle Vue Amusement Park here.

But within a few months it was withdrawn, Belle Vue said, after protests from the United States that the car gave a false impression of American life.

Belle Vue auctioned the car because it was taking up too much room.

LONDON (CP) — Lt. Gen. Sir James (Big Jim) Cassels, who led the Commonwealth division in Korea, is being mentioned as a possible successor to Field Marshal Sir Gerald Templer, 59, who steps down in November as the British army's chief of the imperial general staff, says The Daily Express.
