Co-op Store At Montague May Open Shortly

The new co-op store at Montague is being readied for business as rapidly as possible, so that it may begin operation in the very near future. The former Bergmann building is being remodelled to conform with the plans drawn up with every self service facility, and a wide variety of commodities.

The main store is 66 feet long and 26 feet wide, and will include on the right side wall a fruit counter and groceries, and on the left wall magazines, drugs, groceries, and a dairy display. In the centre will be four large display counters. Two cash clerks near the front will take care of the customers checking out goods.
