## New York Stocks

**NEW YORK (AP)—The bull** market in stocks rolled on to its highest point since 1929 Thursday, backed by volume of 3,000,000 shares: The biggest since April 6, 1933.

Nearly all sections of the list participated in the upswing, which was noteworthy for the strong participation of so-called secondary issues.

The blue chips were active Thursday, but while General Motors and American Telephone advanced a point, such others as Standard Oil N. J. and General Electric lost fractions.

Aircrafts started the ball rolling. Word from Washington that \$1,000,000,000 worth of aircraft will be contracted for shortly brought quick gains in North American, Boeing, Douglas and other issues.

An exception to the uptrend were oil stocks. Many were deeper and a few such as Amerada, Deep Rock and Union Oil, lost a point.

Lower Canadian stocks included Canadian Pacific, down 1-4, and International Nickel, Hiram Walker and Distillers Seagram, each off 1-8.

Canadian stocks on the American stock exchange were mixed. Giant Yellowknife fell 1-8 and Royalite Oil advanced 1-8.
