

**NAVAL APPOINTMENT**  
 LONDON (Reuters)—The admiralty announced Thursday night that Rear-Admiral R. A. Currie, commanding officer of the Royal Navy's experimental cruiser Cumberland, has been appointed chief of staff to the chairman of the British joint services mission in Washington. He will succeed Maj.-Gen. C. R. Price in December.

**DISTURBING STATISTIC**  
 OTTAWA (CP)—New Zealand's government is "disturbed" about an increase of two in its unemployment roll this year, a dinner meeting was told by T. C. A. Hislop, New Zealand high commissioner to Canada. He said 27 of his country's 2,000,000 people were out of work.

**Canada's Imports Down For July**

OTTAWA (CP)—Reduced purchases of a variety of iron and steel products, textiles and coal cut Canada's imports by 15.8 per cent in July, compared with the corresponding month in 1953. The bureau of statistics reported Friday the sixth monthly decrease in dollar value, \$64,189,000. Imports from all countries last July fell to \$341,246,900 from \$405,435,000.  
 The import value in the first seven months was \$2,391,358,000, a drop of 8.8 per cent from \$2,621,998,000 in a similar period last year. The only monthly increase this year was in June when imports rose to \$416,100,000 from \$406,300,000 in June, 1953.  
 Canada purchased less farm machinery, motor vehicles and parts, engines, boilers, raw and finished textiles and fibres, and coal.

**Australian Spy Probe Commissioners Name Author of Libellous "Document J"**

SYDNEY, Australia, (Reuters)—An Australian Communist newspaper man, Rupert Lockwood, was the author of the libellous "Document J" handed to Australian security agents by the former Soviet spy, Vladimir Petrov, the Australian spy probe commission decided tonight.  
 It was the first decision announced by the three commissioners since they began hearings after Petrov's defection to the West last April with his wife.  
 Petrov was formerly the chief of the MVD (secret police) in the Soviet embassy in Canberra, where he was first secretary.  
 Judge William Owen, the chairman, said the commission's decision over "Document J" absolves the Commonwealth security service from any suggestions of conspiracy.  
 Herbert Ewart, leader of the Labor opposition, alleged when he appeared before the commission in defence of two of his staff that the document was a "fake".  
 Owen said the commissioners

**Says CBC Shoves TV Programs On Advertisers**

TORONTO (CP) The Telegram said Friday some Canadians in advertising, radio and independent television productions charge the CBC is using Canadian taxpayers' money to "shove TV programs down advertisers' throats."  
 It said these Canadians, who declined use of their names, claim Canadian advertisers must buy the TV productions the CBC wants them to buy if they are to reach the main marketing areas of Montreal, Toronto, Winnipeg and Vancouver.  
 Its story added that the persons making the accusations say that, when the programs are bought, the CBC underwrites up to 40 per cent of production costs and the sponsors have little or nothing to say about the talent used.  
 "In other words," it quoted an advertising agency man as saying, "the CBC does just exactly as it pleases and over 100 Canadian advertisers, who won't take programs they don't want, are left out in the cold."

**CONTAINS "LIBELS"**  
 The document, most of which remains a secret of the commission, was described earlier in the hearings by Judge Owen as containing "libels" against many Australians.  
 Thursday W. V. Windeyer, commission counsel, said there was nothing in the document to suggest that Lockwood, Fergan O'Sullivan, former press secretary to Ewart, or Albert Grudeman and Alan Dalziel, members of Ewart's staff, had done anything contrary to law.  
 Lockwood has persistently denied that he wrote any part of the document. O'Sullivan, also alleged to have typed some of it, has also denied it.  
 Thursday he filed a writ in the high court here challenging the validity of the commission and its right to make an interim report.

**Leave Toronto For Caribbean Sea**  
 TORONTO (CP)—Six adventurous young men Friday said goodbye to Toronto and headed into Lake Ontario on board the 50-foot yawl they hope will take them to the Caribbean sea.  
 Skipper Jeff Kirkwood, 31, and his five companions will cruise to New York and then set sail for Miami. Kirkwood, born in Sydney, Australia is a former managing editor of the Kirkland Lake Northern Daily News.  
 The departure Friday was the culmination of almost a year's planning which began when Kirkwood and Jim Hanney, 30, also an ex-newspaper man, advertised for "fellow adventurers" to share expenses on the trip they planned.  
 Each of the six has a \$900 investment in the project. On arrival at La Guaira, chief port of Venezuela, they hope to establish a fish-carrying business.  
 The other crew members are Ron Hollick, 22, George Rackus, Geoff Buxton and Peter Scott.

**Canada's Pipeline Mileage Increases**  
 OTTAWA, (CP)—Canada's oil pipeline mileage increased by 82 per cent last year.  
 There were 3,794 miles of pipeline at the end of 1953, 1,294 miles more than at the end of 1950, the bureau of statistics reported Tuesday.  
 The number of pumping stations rose to 45 from 33 during the year, and the flow of oil was stepped up to 151,653,187 barrels from 108,818,688 in 1952.  
 Bakeries across Canada employed 33,420 persons in 1953, or 400 more than the previous year.
