U. S. Steel Report

CLEVELAND (AP)—Because of "so much" building construction, steel business is going to be "pretty good" for the rest of the year. Steel magazine, making that prediction Sunday, commented that "you don't have depressions or even sharp recession when that mainstay of business is at such a high level."

Products for construction and contractors accounted for 20.1 per cent of all finished steel shipped during April. The metal working journal continued, compared with 15.9 per cent during April of last year.

Figures were 1,017,714 net tons of such products during this April, compared with 1,096,832 for the

same month a year ago. Total production was considerably more last year. The magazine pointed out, however, that ingot production increased by half a percentage point last week to 73.5 per cent of the nation's rated capacity of around 123,000,000 tons annually. It was the sixth straight week production has increased.

The magazine's composite of finished steel prices held steady last week at \$113.50 a new ton. Its composite on scrap dropped 34 cents to \$27.83 a gross ton.
