British Gov't Not Decided On Tipping

LONDON, Aug. 31—(CP)—After an official inquiry which lasted nearly a year, official Britain still can't decide what to do about tipping in hotels and restaurants.

The problem was described as urgent when the war ended. Now, a Government-appointed commission which has been studying catering wages has submitted its report. It says the whole question of tipping should be referred to a national committee—as a matter of urgency.
Trade reaction was indignant. The Caterers' Association of Great Britain said the commission had just 'shelved the whole problem.'

Another matter considered by the commission was the Government's Catering Wages Act, a massive set of regulations known in the trade as the Factory Whistle Act. Many hotel managers have claimed that it is ruining the industry. One of the chief complaints has been that the new wages structure makes it difficult for hotels to provide normal service in abnormal hours.

The commission confined itself to minor recommendations for improvement.

WINNIPEG, Aug. 31—(CP)—All grain developed weaker tones in trading today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Trading was quite active.
The lower trend was attributed to declines in United States markets across the board, increased selling coincidental with extension of the harvest season and removal of uncertainty caused by termination of the rail strike.
Commercial demand appeared, with some shipper interest noticeable in oats and barley futures. Support was not aggressive and there were some hedging sales.
Rye followed the trend set by other grains and early gains marked up in flax were either reduced or erased in late trade.
No wheat export business was reported. Indications were, however, that 200,000 bushels of barley have been taken by Belgium.
