Red Squirrel - high numbers of squirrels were reported at feeders in Queens and Kings Counties. Several at one feeder at a time were not uncommon.

Striped Skunk - 1 at Donagh, February 10 (JDM)

Ermine - 1 at suet feeder at Baldwin's Road, noon December 27 (GS)
