"CPR Workshop set for Saturday, February 5 in Charlottetown."

The PEI Division of the Canadian Heart Foundation is offering a four hour workshop in cardiopulmonary resuscitation on Saturday, February 5 in the Lower Foyer, Confederation Center of the Arts in Charlottetown.

Beginning at 9 a.m., the workshop teaches basic C.P.R. and related life saving methods for heart attack victims and choking victims.

The workshop is just one of a series held throughout the year across Prince Edward Island. In the past year alone, an estimated 1,300 have received extensive or basic training in C.P.R. including about 500 in the Cardigan District, 500 in the Egmont District and an additional 300 in Queen's County. A Foundation Spokesman says these figures do not include per-

sons who were recertified in C.P.R. training, the estimated 125 volunteer instructors who work with the Heart Foundation on PEI, or federally funded community development workers who coordinate lectures, public education sessions to community groups, augmenting volunteer instructors to reach more citizens and target groups.

Advance registration for the February 5 C.P.R. workshop is requested by February 2 by contacting the Heart Foundation office at 894-8297 in Charlottetown.

The \$10.00 registration fee can be paid when registering at Confederation Center of the Arts. The program includes audio-visual aids, as well as personal instruction on manikins to teach and test abilities for reviving heart attack victims.

\$6,500. Grant

awarded to UPEI

The University has been awarded \$6,500 under the Management Excellence in Small Business Program introduced by the federal government in June, 1982.

The \$4,500 student scholarship and \$2,000 course development grant to the University are among the first offered to Canadian university and community college business schools across the country under the program. Twenty schools have received Management Excellence in Small Business Program (MESBP) funding totalling \$210,000.

MESBP, which is administered by the Small Business Secretariat, is intended

to foster closer continuing relations between the business schools and the small business community.
