Says Much Gold Is Being Stolen From Porcupine Mines

TIMMINS, Ont. (CP) — Gold worth more than all the money taken in Ontario bank holdups in a year is being stolen each month from mines in the Porcupine district, Provincial Police Inspector Charles W. Wood said Saturday.

He said one estimate placed the value of gold stolen across Canada each year at more than \$1,000,000 at the black market figure of between \$23 and \$45 an ounce. It could be much higher, he said.

Insp. Wood, with the anti-high-grade division of the provincial police, made the statement in a lecture to officers attending the Porcupine Chamber of Commerce police school.

Stolen Canadian gold, he said, finds its way to Israel where, at \$86 an ounce, it is used to buy guns and military supplies. It turns up in Belgium in exchange for diamonds and in the Orient for narcotics.

The price of gold is pegged on the United States market at approximately \$35 (U.S.) an ounce. **GOES TO EUROPE**

Through Interpol, the international police system, it has been determined that a great demand exists in Europe for Canadian gold. Insp. Wood said. Most of Canada's stolen gold was being smuggled there.

The 1953 gold conference placed the value of gold stolen in Canada in excess of \$1,000,000 on the black market.

Stolen gold carries no serial numbers and cannot be returned to its owner. Much of it ends up in the federal treasury.

Gold stolen in the Porcupine district takes several forms — nuggets, ore and semi-refined. Syndicates, aided by dishonest miners, are blamed for the thefts. Smelting of the contraband is done in homes in the district and the finished product taken out by individuals, some unsuspectingly aiding the rings by carrying parcels to outside contacts.
