Local and Other Items.

THEY WANT TO FIGHT.—It is said that a large number of men belonging to the British first class reserve residing in Halifax have offered themselves for service in South Africa.

HISTORICAL MONUMENT.—In October of this year a Presbyterian historical monument will be unveiled in Monmouth County, N. J. It will be in commemoration of the first recorded ordination by a Presbytery in the United States. This was on December 20, 1706.

MANITOBA GRAIN CROP.—A Winnipeg despatch says: The summer crop bulletin just issued by the Department of Agriculture estimates the total grain crop at 62 million bushels. New samples of wheat show the best crop Manitoba has had for some years.

RAILWAY CONVENTION.—The Railway Men's Christian Convention will open in St. John, N. B., on Friday morning at 9 standard. The day session will be held in St. Stephen's Church, Saturday night in the Baptist Church, Sunday morning in Zion Church, Sunday night, farewell meeting in St. David's Church. By courtesy of the Canada Pacific Railway there will be an excursion to Westfield on Saturday afternoon.

END OF THE WORLD.—Reports from southern Russia say that a rumor of the approaching end of the world is causing a panic among the uneducated class. At Keakou, the capital of the Government of that name, workmen are leaving the city in large numbers, wishing to spend what they consider their last days at their village homes. The factory owners have asked the police to stop this emigration, in order to prevent the ruin of their business.

EXPLOSIVES FOUND.—While Edouard Parier, a C. P. R. freight clerk, was counting money in the station at Joliette, Que., the other day a coin fell and dropped through a crack in the cellar, which is never used. While searching for the missing coin Parier came across several packages which on being removed were found to contain thirty pounds of powder, fourteen sticks of dynamite, a coil of fuse and six caps, a pair of rubber soled shoes and an electric battery. The dynamite was wrapped up in newspapers. Several detectives are endeavoring to solve the mysterious robbery of \$7,015 from the station, and they look upon this find of explosives as an important clue. Never before has such daring robberies been perpetrated in Canada, as have been this last few months in Quebec and Ontario.

OBITUARY.

Died at Cherry Grove, Souris, Line Road, on Friday the 18th inst., after an illness of two months, Alexander Moeberch in the 54th year of his age. His death was caused by cancer of the stomach, which slowly but surely carried off its victim. The deceased was a good neighbor and a successful farmer, and will long have a fond place in the memories of the good people of Cherry Grove and the vicinity. His funeral took place on Sunday 20th, at 2 o'clock p. m., when, fully one hundred carriages followed his remains to St. Mary's Cemetery, Souris East. He leaves one brother, a wife and four of a family, to mourn his irreparable loss.
