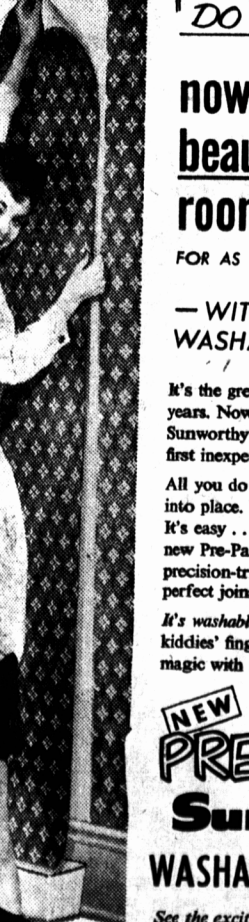

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No Drastic Change In 1956 Styles Says Designer Dior

TORONTO (CP)—"Knees," says Paris designer Christian Dior, "are not as pretty as bussums." But although Mr. Dior may have some difficulty in pronouncing "bosoms," he states emphatically that they have an important place in the fashions of the immediate future.

With that in mind, the famed French designer keeps mi'lady's knees under cover.

NO DRASTIC CHANGES

Mr. Dior, who arrived in Toronto Thursday to renew old acquaintances, said there will be no "drastic changes" in women's styles next season.

But, he adds, "even savages must have styles," so there will be a few adjustments in 1956. He had a pat on the back for Canadian designers. Canadians, he said, "need not be envious of any other country" when it comes to fashion. But Canadian designers still had to take the lead from Paris.

Mr. Dior's lawyers estimate his current designs worth \$1,350,000. "That's the figure he and some fellow Paris designers are asking a judge to get from four United States 'cut-rate' style houses. They stole our patterns, and their reproductions aren't even accurate," he said.

"NEW LOOK" FAME

In 1947 Mr. Dior was a relative unknown in the fashion world when he hit Paris with his below-the-knees "new look."

He's gone to the "H", the "A" and the "Y"-look since then.

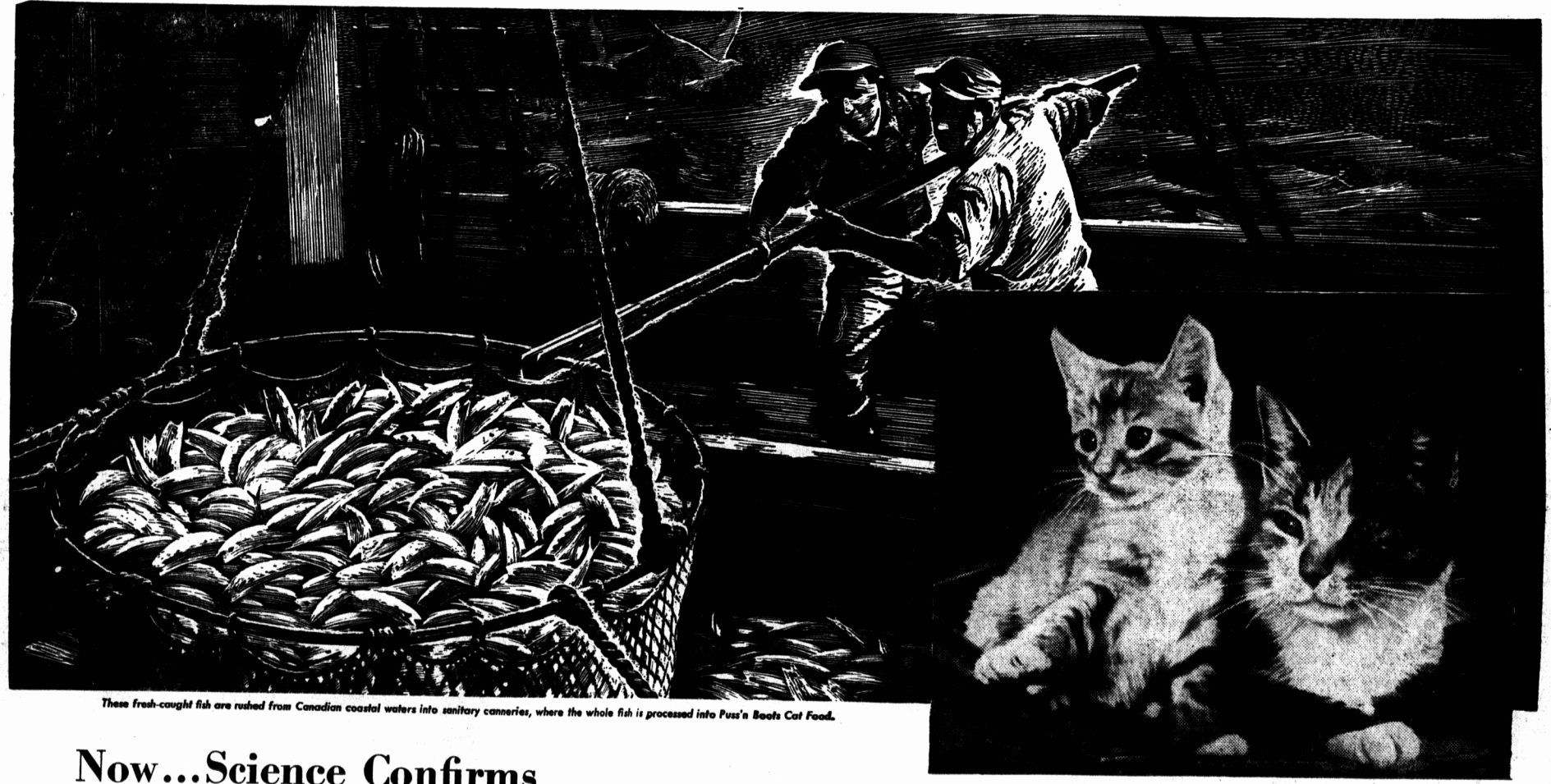

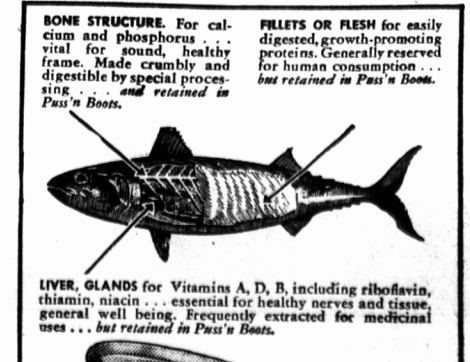
