Feb. - Nothing scheduled yet

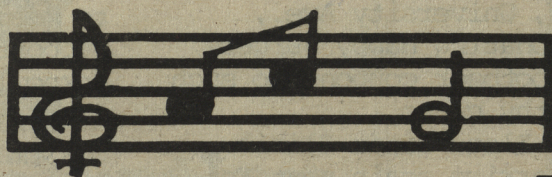
Feb. 26 - George Bowering, a Canadian poet from Vancouver, reading his poetry
