The first heat in this event was won by Hilda Mac (Bernard) but due to an accident she had to be drawn for the third heat, best time 2:20 by Prodigal Vic. Other winners were: No. 2 Classified, Julia Abner (Craig) 1-3-1, Lady Abner (Bernard) 3-1-2, three other starters, best time 2:19 by Julia Budlong, which is a new track pacing record. The No. 3 Classified was won by Bonnie Clegg (Smith) with 2-1-1, Laddy Dale (Ferguson)

1-3-4, two other starters, best time 2:22 by Laddy Dale.

P. J. Cadegan, who owns one of the best racing stables in the Maritimes with horses that have been frequent winners at the Sydney night races and elsewhere this season, paid a brief visit here last week and we understand his stable will ship here in the near future. Glancing over the summaries we note that his driver Worrell Lewis, who was leading driver of the Maritimes last season, is keeping up his end of the game, being first thirty times, second fourteen times, third nine times and fourth ten times, which most certainly gives him a long lead on fellow drivers throughout the Maritimes. A noted accomplishment of Worrell's was the removal of the hoppers from Ohio Hal and the winning of both dashes without them.

At Truro last Tuesday night race No. 2 was won by the five-year-old pacing gelding, Gallonage, own-

ed and driven by H. M. Sweeney, Bridgewater, time 2:17. He is by Bill Gallon, sire of Brewer's Gallon 2:02 1-4 and was sold at the Harrisburg sale last November. The owner's statement said that he showed more speed in training than any pacer he had ever owned and had worked a half mile track in 2:10. We hope he will prove another Brewer's Gallon. Local admirers of Miss Cherry Valley, formerly owned by Wilfred Fraught, must have been pleased to notice that she was again a winner at Truro, heading several real pacers in 2:14 for owner-driver Clayton MacLeod of Westville. This is a new record for her. Colleen Adam, that races all through the fall and winter months and is out again the first meet of the season, won No. 8 Dash at the above meeting from Dudy Budlong, Single Streak, Starlight Eclipse and Seven Up Direct in 2:12 3-5, which is within three-fifths of a second of her record. She is owned and was driven by

Laurie O'Brien. Single Streak (Conroy) had won the previous dash in 2:14 2-6, with Seven Up Direct 2 Dudy Budlong 3. Another much improved pacer this season is Billy P. C. Parker (Daniels) that won dashes 3 and 6—the latter in 2:15 2-5.

In the No. 3 Classified Donald G. R. (Barnett) was 8-1-1, Our Scott (Reid) 1-2-2; two other starters, time, 2:11 3-5, 2:11 2-5, 2:10, which is at least the second 2:10 mile for the former Summerside, owned pacer this season. In the No. 4 Classified Indiana Boy, owned by Bob Brown and driven by Tommy Eter, was 2-1-1, with Jo Jo Spencer (Barnett) 1-2-2, best time 2:12 by Indiana Boy. Jo Jo Spencer started the season

with a record of 2:10 and has cut several seconds off it and is considered one of the best slow class prospects in the Maritimes.

In the Junior Free For All Guy Majesty, owned and driven by Thomas G. Seely of Fort Fairfield, Maine, was the winner with 3-1-1, Tab Hanover (Simonson) another Maine free-for-all was 1-4-2, three other starters, best time 2:08 2-5 by Guy Majesty.

The following is a recent release from the publicity department of Saratoga Raceway, New York: "Making a strong bid for top hon-

ors among the fast trotters at our summer meeting is Brewer's Gallon. The five-year-old son of Bill Gallon, the ace of Joe O'Brien's stable, has topped three in a row, his last in 2:05 3-5." He was born in Holland and came to the United States in 1918, settling in California in 1935. For a number of years his racing stable has been prominent in the Grand Circuit, his favorite trotter being Vita Lee 2:02 2-5. This season his four-year-old Robert Morris took a record of 2:00 and others in his stable were frequent winners or in the money. For the past nine months his stable has been trained and raced by Joe O'Brien, who was

very much attached to Mr. DeVreis and will certainly feel very badly about his death.

only matched trotters including Christie Budlong making her comeback after two years away from the turf. Another popular class will include Billy Conn, Quick Lick, Miss Donna Mae, Josedale Hoosier, Lucky Number, All American and Dorothy Wont Tell. In addition there are four other dashes.

The entry list for Old Home Week races August 14-19 which appears in this issue is certainly extraordinary. Nothing like that number of horses—242—has ever been entered in a race meet in the Maritimes and possibly not in Canada.
