OTTAWA (CP) — The transport department reported today that this winter's ice conditions in the Gulf St. Lawrence were not as serious as last year.

In a report on operations by Canada's Coast Guard icebreakers in the Gulf, the department said ice conditions were moderate to heavy in the Gulf. "At no time did conditions become as difficult as in the previous winter when a major icebreaker was stranded in the main land."

After March 15, icebreaking was necessary only in Maritimes and Newfoundland waters.
