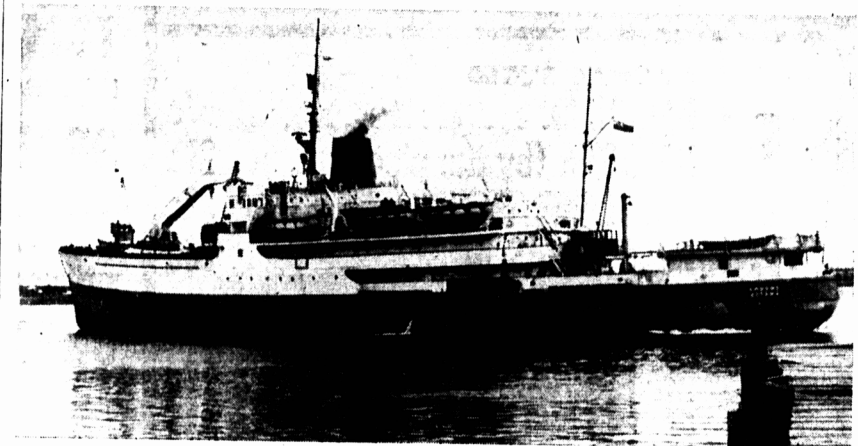
MONTREAL (CP)—An American army general Tuesday praised the Canadian army saying it always manages to settle differences with the United States forces "in no time at all."
