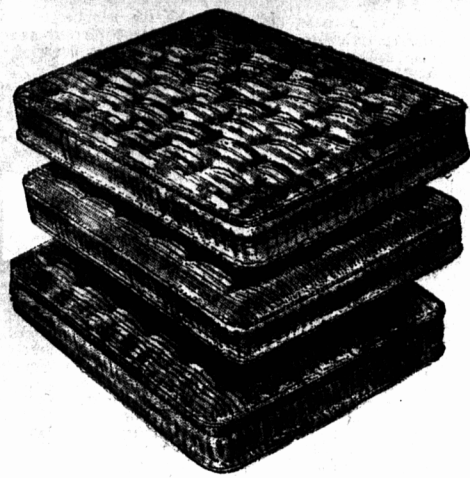

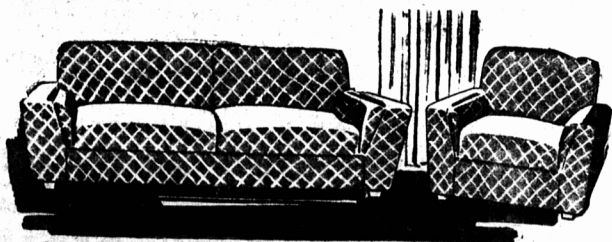

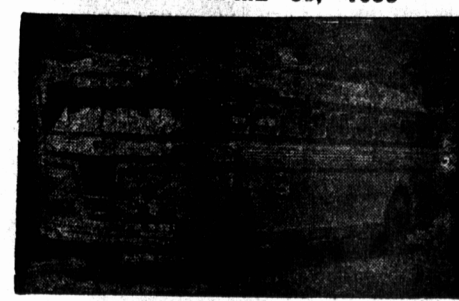
HALIFAX, (CP)—A Nova Scotia education department official said Tuesday part of the importance attached to grading children through school stems from parental unwillingness to lose face.
