Youth Travel Discount Plan

Air Canada and CN have joined forces to offer young travellers the best from Air Canada's Swing Air Club and CN's Youth Plan. Anyone between the age of 12 and 21 is eligible.

Air Fare: 33.3% discount on Air Canada's services anywhere in North America, on a 'stand-by' basis, economy class, including on jumbo jet 747.

Rail Fare: Canadian National offers a 25% saving on regular coach rail fares if the trip commences on a red or white day. The regular price of the fare on red days must be \$9.00 or more.

Hotels: Discounts as high as 50% usually on a space-available basis. Hotel chains offering discounts are:

- CN operated hotels (except Jasper Park Lodge)
- Sheraton Hotels (Canada and U.S.)
- Skyline Hotels (Canada)
- Hilton Hotels (U.S.)
- Most Canadian Pacific Hotels (Canada)

Many other independent hotels and motels in most major cities, also offer youth discounts. Check with the hotel of your choice for more information.
