P.C. Catholic Welfare Drive Reaches The Half Way Mark

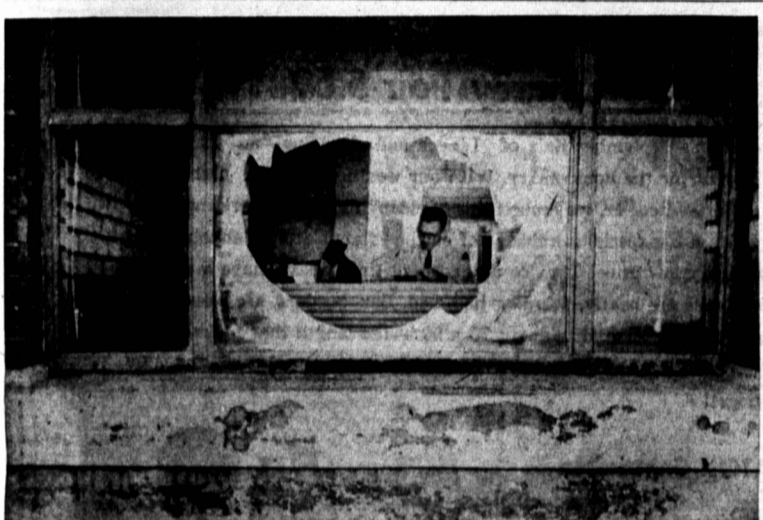

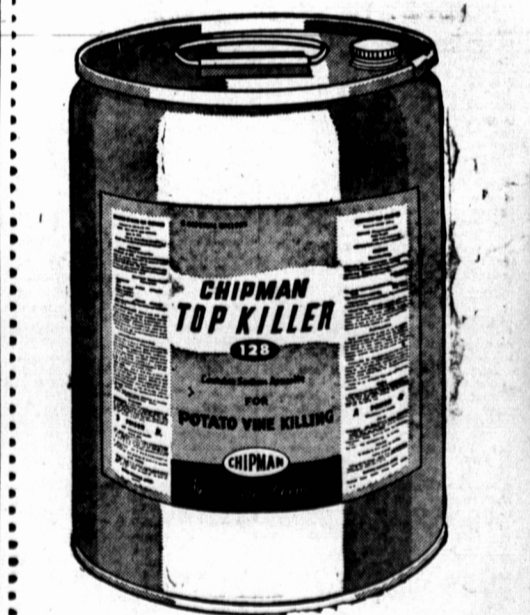
