

Drury Confirms Contract Plans In Shipbuilding

OTTAWA (CP)—The government will put all shipbuilding contracts up for national competition but guarantee British Columbia yards a certain percentage of work until 1970, Industry Minister Drury confirmed.

The ministers statement did not say what percentage of the total will be guaranteed West-Coast shipyards. But this portion will be on an annually decreasing basis until 1970.

In the past, most government shipbuilding contracts—for the defence, transport, mines, fisheries, works and other departments—have been allocated directly to individual yards on a cost-plus basis. This means cost of the ship with an additional payment, usually five per cent of cost, for profit.

Mr. Drury said the new policy is:

1. National competition whenever the nature and operational circumstances of the requirement permit.

2. Area competition where it is not practicable to transfer a vessel from one region to another.

3. Direct allocation to a shipyard only when special circumstances exist such as emergency work or particular jobs which only one shipyard can handle.

Mr. Drury said the government will spend approximately \$394,000,000 between now and 1970 on ships. A forecast of procurement requirements has been given the shipbuilding industry.

14 Canadians Visit Russia

The group is headed by Speaker Alan Macnaughton and Senator David Cross.
