Turnover reached 4,000,000 shares for the week, a record for a week, volume for the week was 4,140,000 shares compared with 3,800,000 for the week ending Jan. 11. Once again, the session was marked by the usual year-end cross of buying and selling, taking, switching, and tax-loss transactions which made up the bulk of the trading. The Dow Jones industrial average closed at 631.43. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks rose to 242.9. The Standard & Poor's average of 400 stocks rose to 186.2.
