WINNIPEG, June 28 - (CP) - Grain prices generally took on an easier tone after a steady opening today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Barely in the session, commercial demand was fair in all grains. Shippers bought up oats and barley, while barley also received support from export accounts. Rye and flax were purchased by locals. However, offerings increased when United States markets turned lower and prices here dropped off. December rye dropped to a new seasonal low. Overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat included 340,000 bushels to Italy and 315,000 to the United Kingdom. I. W. A. and class two wheat prices declined one-eighth cent from yesterday. The Egg Market

Commercial egg marketings through registered grading stations dropped below 90,000 cases for the week ending June 16, reaching that point approximately two weeks earlier than in the last two years. It is reported that reserve stocks from storage are now starting to be drawn on in Ontario. With the decreases in marketings there is a continuation of the upward trend in egg prices. Spot prices at Montreal and Toronto advanced about six cents during the week. Increases, although mostly to a lesser extent than at Montreal and Toronto, were general in Western Canada. No reports have been received yet that withdrawals from storage have started in Western Canada to supplement fresh supplies, but it is normal for this movement to start a few weeks later in the west than in the east. One reason for that, of course, is that Western Canada has a relatively larger percentage of the Canadian laying hen population in relation to human population than has Eastern Canada, so that the seasonal decline in egg production in the west can reach a rather more advanced point before there is an actual scarcity of fresh egg supplies to meet the local demand. The relation of human population to laying hen population is shown by Provinces except for Newfoundland, for which figures of hen population are not available.
