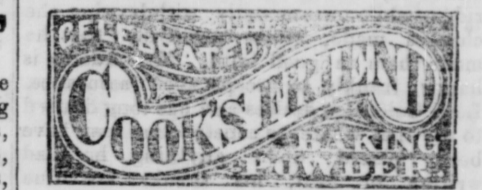

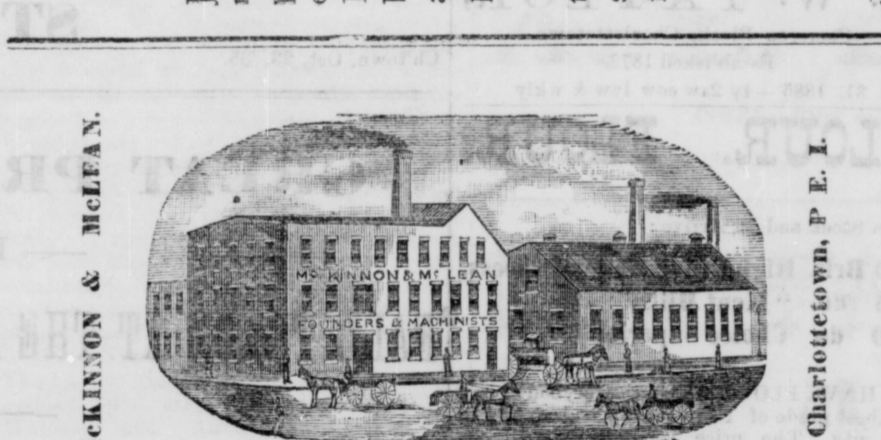

CURRENT NOTES.

The more Turkey is tried, the more there will be of Greece.

Grave fears have arisen that small-pox will become epidemic in St. Paul. "To jarret," meaning "to abduct," has made its appearance in English journals.

It is estimated that the Prohibition vote in New York State on Tuesday reached 40,000 more than double the vote of last year.

It is estimated that there are 35,000 newspapers and other periodicals published in the world. The United States has a total of 13,494, while the Dominion of Canada has 644 and Newfoundland 9.

"Eh, doctor," said a baillie of a small Scotch town to a friend, "he man hae been an extraordinary man, that Shakespeare. There are things ha come into his head that never would hae come into mine at a."

Instead of wishing to drive the Chinese into the sea, the Mexicans are so anxious to multiply the numbers of these industrious laborers in their midst, that a bounty is offered of twenty-five dollars a head to the steamship company that will land them in that country.

A writer of an English journal says: "I have been used to the Ayrshire cow in her native country, and now have a herd in the South. I have seen her tried side by side with the short-horns and some other breeds, and I have no hesitation whatever in saying that, taking the cost of production into account, the Ayrshire is the best all-round dairy cow in the British Islands.

The epitaph composed by the Bishop of Land-iff and engraved on the National Tomb Memorial which is about to be unveiled in Canterbury Cathedral, is as follows: "A great Archbishop, just, discerning, dignified; a Statesman, wise to know the time, and resolute to redeem it, both by word and good example, all who love things true and pure, beautiful and of good report."

The scandal of popular drunkenness will doubtless be much abated in Russia by the new Excise Law which is to go into force at the beginning of the new year. All the saloons which exist merely for the purpose of retailing grog will be closed, to the number of at least 80,000. The sale of liquors will be permitted only in hotels and restaurants, and licenses in these will be limited in number, according to the judgment of the Excise officers, and a fee of \$825 exacted for each.

Canon Farrar, to an interviewer said recently: "I have always been in favor of perfecting the education of women, but I think there are not a large number of women who can stand the strain of competition. There are some few gifted ones who are equal to this great strain, and to them should be accorded all possible advantages. This question of the higher education of women has made great strides in England in the last ten years." Canon Farrar doesn't know how much of the strain of competition American and Canadian women can stand, or he would not touch the subject of the higher education of women so gingerly.
