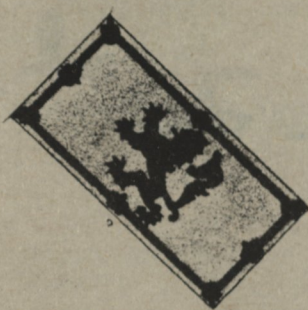
## HISTORY SOCIETY
