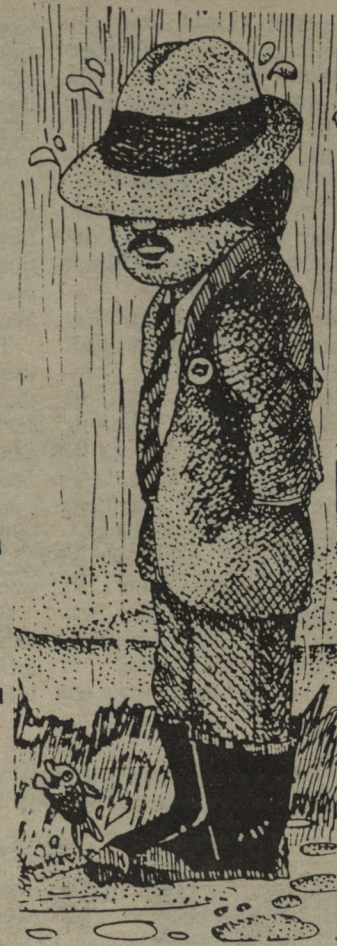

NUKE

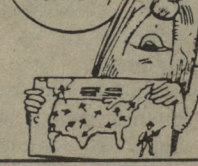
We've long had a policy of Mutually Assured Destruction called MAD for short.
