L'ETAT DE NOS FINANCES

D'APRES LE DERNIER LIVRE BLEU

Le gouvernement du tarif pour le revenu, qui gouverne le pays, a un surplus pour l'année fiscale 1900-1901 de \$5,648,335 avec un revenu total de \$52,514,701.

Ce sont les chiffres qui paraissent au livre bleu des comptes publics. Cependant en soustrayant de ce surplus le déficit à compte du capital, on se trouve en présence d'un déficit net de 2,986,196. Les dépenses au compte du capital ont été de 11,116,499, dont \$2,633,383 pour l'P. E. R. et \$286,17 pour les canaux du St-Laurent, travaux publics \$1,006,983, dont \$800,000 au Yukon et sur l'approfondissement du St-Laurent. La guerre d'Afrique a coûté \$1,000,000; les subvention aux chemins de fer, \$2,512,328.

Le revenu du Yukon depuis 1895, a été de \$6,700,193 et les dépenses \$5,945,216, soit un surplus de \$754,977.

Le revenu de l'P. E. R. a été de \$4,972,245, ou \$420,164 de plus qu'en 1899-1900. Les dépenses ont augmenté en 1900-1901, de \$1,029,017 sur le chiffre de l'année précédente, soit un déficit de 488,186.

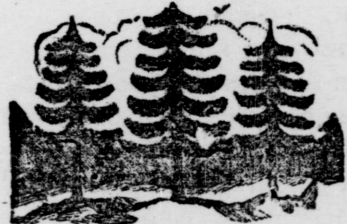

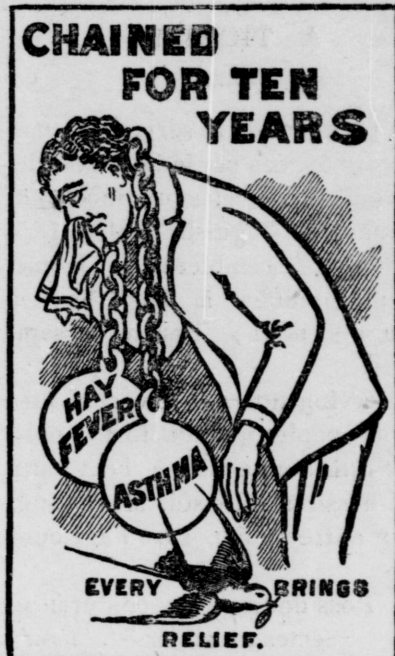
