

## MP For Queens States Views

OTTAWA Heath Macquarrie, MP for Queens, said at Ottawa Thursday that the P.E.I. Liberal party could be put in a difficult position by the federal Liberal government's handling of the province's Senate vacancy.

Mr. Macquarrie has returned to Ottawa after several days in the province and reports intense interest and activity in the deferred election in First Kings. He said that while the campaign issues were mainly provincial or local there were some external matters and issues which will have an impact on the tense contest upon which control of the Island legislature rests.

"One of these is the filling of the vacancy in P.E.I. Senate representation and there are increasingly strong rumors that one of the candidates defeated in Queens County in the May 30 election is expected to receive the appointment," Mr. Macquarrie said. "Just as the deferral of the causeway construction and the increase in ferry rates embarrassed their provincial colleagues, so could Ottawa's handling of the vacancy in P.E.I. Senate representation and there are increasingly strong rumors that one of the candidates defeated in Queens County in the May 30 election is expected to receive the appointment," Mr. Macquarrie said.

## Selma Owen Passes Away

During the war she served in the United States Nursing Corps and saw service in North Africa and Italy and was retired from active service with the rank of Captain. In 1946 she entered the employ of the U.S. Government Veterans Administration and for approximately six years was stationed at the V.A. Hospital, Staten Island, New York, and in 1951 transferred to the V.A. Hospital in Albany, New York, where she was nursing supervisor of the surgical floor.

When the new V.A. Hospital, Albany, N.Y. commemorated ten years of service in 1961, Miss Owen was honored with the Florence Nightingale Award and during the past year received a special Commendation for distinguished, unselfish and dedicated service to nursing.

ENTERS HOSPITAL  
In February, 1966, Miss Owen entered the V.A. Hospital, Albany, N.Y. for surgery and from that hospital was invalided to Charlottetown, P.E.I. via U.S. Army plane on March 22, 1966, and since that time resided at the home of her sister, Mary (Mrs. G.E. Ives, Surviving sisters are Lois (Mrs. O.D. MacGregor) of Halifax, Violet (Mrs. Alfred Steffensen) of Wellington, New Zealand, Delys (Mrs. Colin Quin) Willowdale, Ontario, Mary (Mrs. George Ives) and Florence of Charlottetown. Surviving brothers are Cambridge of Charlottetown; Edward, supervisor department Bank of Nova Scotia, Vancouver, B.C.; William, manager Bank of Montreal, Hartland, N.B.; Maitland, Abitibi Power and Paper Company, Iroquois Falls, Ontario; Robert, Department of Transport, Moncton, N.B. The bell was dubbed "Old Donald" after Donald MacKinnon, who was the chief of the city's fire department in 1875. But the city bell has had some troubles—it was badly cracked once and shattered on another occasion.

The first crack came some years after it was installed and it was shipped back to Boston, from where it had been purchased and re-cast.

It was recast somewhat smaller than the original, with the foundry retaining sufficient metal to pay for the cost of the recasting.

A mad cow escaped its tether in Montague yesterday morning. The cow was bought yesterday by Joe Fraser. The previous day the cow lost its calf at birth.

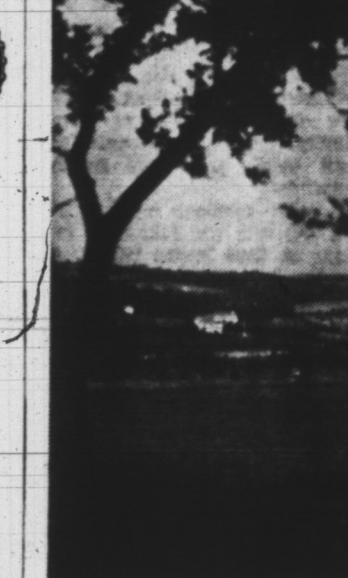
