

Marshfield on Feb. 2 (GC); **Northern Flicker** - 1 seen at Monticello from Jan. 10-15 (GM), 1 at Charlottetown feeder on Jan. 31 (LT); **Black-backed Woodpecker** - a female feeding on insect damaged white spruce at Blooming Point on Nov. 9 (BB, JDM), 1 seen on Larch tree at Bonshaw on Feb. 2 (WMac); **Gray Jay** - 2 in Dromore on Nov. 10 (JDM, BB); **Boreal Chickadee** - sightings have been up in Central Queens County this year (JDM); **Northern Mockingbird** - 1 at Ravenwood in Parkdale eating grapes on Nov. 26 (JW); **American Robin** - 1 in November at Southport (CAC), 1 at North River in early Jan. (AMacE); **Townsend's Solitaire** - 1 at Peggy Jenkin's feeder on Nov. 27 (FRC); **Bohemian Waxwing** - 19 at Blooming Point on Nov. 9 (JDM, BB), 16 at Marshfield on Nov. 30 (PJ), in Dec. and Jan. many reports received across central and eastern P.E.I. with groups of from 4 to 150 being reported in crab apple trees, rose bushes, and high bush cranberry bushes as well as certain other fruit trees and shrubs (BFR, BH, DMacL, C&MW, AS); **Cedar Waxwing** - 12 at Souris on Nov. 10 (MR); **Northern Shrike** - 1 in Belfast/Pinette area on Jan. 27 (EN); **Red-winged Blackbird** - 1 at Indian River feeder in early Dec. (TC); **Northern Oriole** - pair nesting at Parkdale for the past ten years (J&CC); **Northern Cardinal** - a female at Monticello feeder on Nov. 17 - 19 (GM), a female at Kildare River feeder for last 2 days on Nov. 26 (TdA), female at Cherry Hill feeder on Dec. 4 (LC); **Common Grackle** - 1 at feeder on Jan. 26 at Brackley (RP); **Evening Grosbeak** - sighting reports are down but TC had 25+ at her Indian River feeder in early Dec., 50 were at a Mount Herbert feeder (KJ, EJ); **Pine Grosbeak** - sporadic feeder sighting reports being received this January; **Hoary Redpoll** - 1 at Hartz Road feeder with a dozen Common Redpoll (C&MW); **Common Redpoll** - reports common in Dec.-Jan. with at least 6 feeders reporting redpolls (LD, ECo, BC, BH, et al); **Pine Siskin** - certain feeder operators reporting them before the Jan. 18th rainstorm. ECo reported that they disappeared for a period after this storm; **Rufous-sided Towhee** - female at Bunbury (SEV), 1 at Tea Hill on Nov. 10 (WC, DSc); **American Tree Sparrow** - 1 to 4 at Donagh feeder Nov.-Jan. (JDM); 1 at feeder in Southport on Dec. 26 (CAC); **Swamp Sparrow** - 1 at Marshfield feeder on Nov. 20 (PJ); **Song Sparrow** - 1 at Hartz Road feeder in January (C&MW); **Snow Bunting** - flocks of 15 to 30 flying over grain fields in Millview in early Nov., 200 plus on a road and in field at Midgell on Nov. 13 (BB, JDM).
