

Final Standing in Northern Ireland Election

BELFAST. (Reuters)—The right-wing pro-British Unionist party remains in power in Northern Ireland with the same number of seats as in previous Parliament. Final figures for last week's general elections showed Saturday. Queen's University, Belfast

which has the privilege of returning four members of a proportional representation parliament vote. Saturday elected three Unionists and one Independent—against two Unionists and two Independents at the previous elections. But the gain was offset by one loss in last week's polling in the constituencies. Final state of the parties in the 52-seat House of Commons is: Unionists 38, Independent Unionist 1, Nationalists 7, Independent Labor 1, Republican Labor 1, unofficial Irish Labor 1, Independent 1, and two members pledged to abstain.

Majority Of 24 At the dissolution of the state of the parties was: Unionists 37, with one Unionist seat vacant, Independent Unionists 1, Nationalists 9, and Independent 3, Northern Ireland Labor 1. Prime Minister Lord Brookeborough, whose party has held the government since home rule was granted to Northern Ireland 32 years ago, has an over-all majority of 24 against the combined votes of the other members. Most of these included the Nationalists, seek to unite Northern Ireland with the southern republic.
