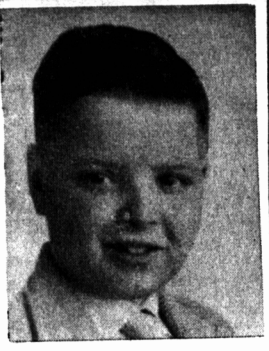

these may drift to adjacent areas, thus endangering plants growing in fields nearby. To avoid this, only amine or low volatile ester formulations of 2,4-D or MCP should be used near gardens and fields of sunflowers, soybeans and rape seed.

Thirdly, steps must be taken to prevent the wind from carrying small droplets of spray solution of any herbicide formulation onto susceptible crops. This is particularly necessary when spraying out-fits which produce fine droplets.

These selective herbicides can be used safely for their recommended uses if the instructions on the container are carefully studied and followed.
