MONTREAL (CP) — The U.S. dollar closed Monday at a discount of 3 2/32 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 1-32. Pound sterling \$2.69 1/2, down 3-16. U.S. dollar bid 96 1-16; asked 96 3-32.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) — The stock market backed off from its highs of the day Monday in moderate trading.

Base metals reached new 1956 highs during the session but closed slightly down. Western Oil reached their peak of 142.69 at noon before sliding back to close at 142.36, ahead one-third.

Base metals were the big losers, off almost one-half. Golds were off a few decimal points.

Golds showed some signs of rallying towards the close but never did get started. Senior mines kept down. International Nickel pulled base metals off, losing 1/80. Fractional losses went to Noranda and Steep Rock.

There wasn't too much action among speculators with the 300,000 mark. Of the three, Purdex was the only winner, up 4 cents at 34. Barnat lost 1/4 cents at \$2.16 while New Hosco was down 55 cents at \$2.70.

Western oils didn't show too much change on the day as several senior issues went up and then lost most of their gains to profit-taking.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) — Prices were irregularly higher, generally within a range of around a point, at the close of moderate trading on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges Monday.

Despite a 1 1/2 loss by Macmillan B, papers backed the winners. Price was up 1/4 and Anglo-Canadian pulp was up a point as gains of 3/4 were made by Abitibi, Brown and Great Lakes Paper.

Utilities and base metals saw a drop of 1/4 by B.C. Telephone and losses of a point each by Asbestos, Jamaica and Quebec Power. Up 1/2 was B.C. Power.

Other industrial groups featured Ford A, up 3/4, General Dynamics up 1/2 and Walker a gain of 3/4.

Changes in a weak penny group were mostly confined to a five-cent range. New Hosco went down 55 cents.

Industrial volume was 71,500 shares, mines and oils, 460,800. Of 242 issues traded, 84 advanced, 62 declined and 96 were unchanged. Two new yearly lows were recorded and 18 new highs.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) — The stock market carried out a record 1958 session in four weeks.

Trading dropped to 2,870,000 shares from Friday's 3,650,000 shares for the lightest day since July 14 when volume amounted to 2,540,000 shares.

Steels were up fractions in the morning, then widened gains after output for this week was estimated at 61.4 per cent of capacity compared with last week's 58.8 per cent.

Of 1,184 stocks traded, advances outnumbered declines 506 to 414, with 264 unchanged.

Aluminium Ltd. lost 1/2 among Canadian issues. Canadian Pacific dropped 1/8. Dome Mines was up 1/8. Hudson Bay Mining ad.

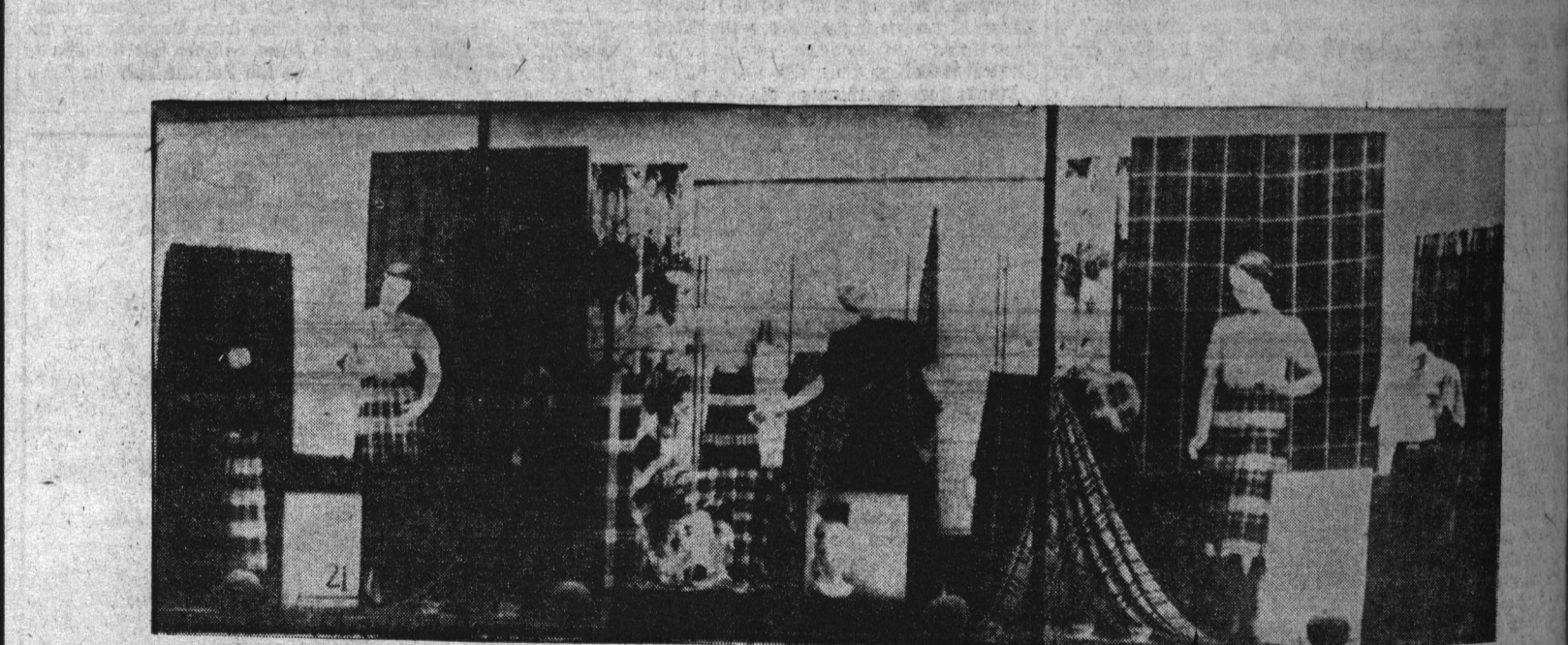
